Kids Cubby Club Rules & Conditions

The objectives of the Diggers Kids Cubby Club is to provide a supervised area for eligible children to attend while accompanying their parents to Diggers Services Club. This area should provide entertainment of a suitable nature and activities that are away from and separate to liquor and gaming areas. Entry to this area is subject to conditions as outlined below. All staff attending The Diggers Kids Cubby Club must hold a "Suitability (blue) Card".

1. The Diggers Kids Cubby Club is for children between the ages of 3 to 12 years. Proof of age may be required
2. Children must be a minimum of three years of age and totally toilet trained to be eligible for membership of The Diggers Kids Cubby Club. Nappies of any kind including "pull ups" are not permitted
3. Children must be registered. All details of each child must be supplied and recorded in the membership database
4. The child will be issued with a membership card showing the child's name and membership number
6. A Parent or Guardian must fill in the Register Book upon arrival
7. The Parent or Guardian registering the child must check on the child every hour or when paged or requested to by a staff member. Collection and "signing out" of all children must be the same person who has registered them on that day
8. Children are not to be left at The Diggers Kids Cubby Club for a period exceeding two hours. If numbers permit, two by two (2) hour blocks are available. The children must have a half hour break in between
9. Parents or Guardians must remain on the Club's premises and notify staff of their location within the Club at all times
10. Parents or Guardians must sign the register every time a child is collected and returned to the Diggers Kids Cubby Club
11. Reservations will be accepted at the discretion of The Diggers Kids Cubby Club supervisors
12. Parents or Guardians must supervise the use of vending machines. No other food or drink is allowed in the Diggers Kids Cubby Club. Water is provided
13. Children who are badly behaved, use bad language or aggressive behaviour will not be permitted to remain in The Diggers Kids Cubby Club
14. All rules of The Diggers Kids Cubby Club are an official policy of the Club and must be adhered to under By Laws 14 and 16(d) of the Constitution. Any breach of these rules may result in termination of membership in accordance with Rule 9.3.2 of the Constitution
15. A Parent who registers a child for membership of The Diggers Kids Cubby Club may also register the names of up to two other persons who may be caring for the child in their absence. These people must also be members of Diggers Services Club. Entry will be refused if registration has not been lodged on the application form and will not be valid if parents are in attendance at the Club
16. The maximum number of children permitted at any one time will be determined by the Diggers Kids Cubby Club supervisor and or Duty Manager and is subject to fluctuation
17. The hours of operation will be determined by management on a needs basis
18. Workplace Health & Safety requirements apply to the Diggers Kids Cubby Club. Children who are ill will not be permitted entry. Parents are advised that any attempt to ignore this rule will be dealt with by the Judiciary Committee
19. Dress Rules of the Club apply to Children. Footwear must be worn outside The Diggers Kids Cubby Club at all times. No caps will be permitted at any time
20. Bags or backpacks are not permitted
22. Management reserves the right to refuse admittance
23. In the event of an evacuation, please do not attempt to collect children from the Cubby. Staff will escort all children to the designated meeting area (car park) in accordance with our evacuation procedures
24. All children must leave the Diggers Kids Cubby Club by 9.00pm
